Then explore 60 acres of magnificent formal gardens, find the centre of the Maze and storm the battlements in the Magic Garden.

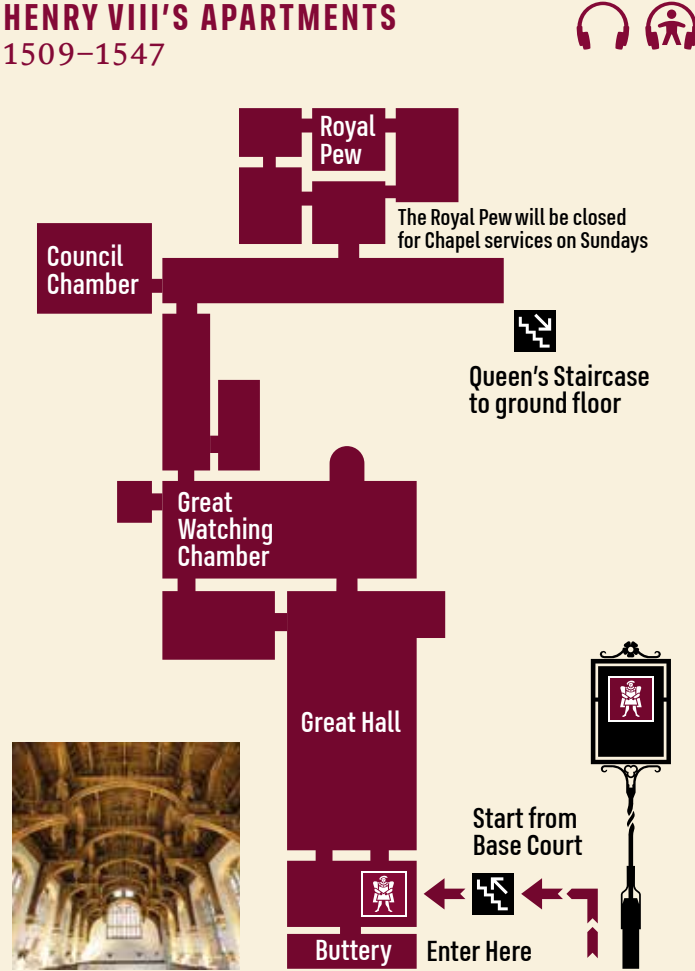

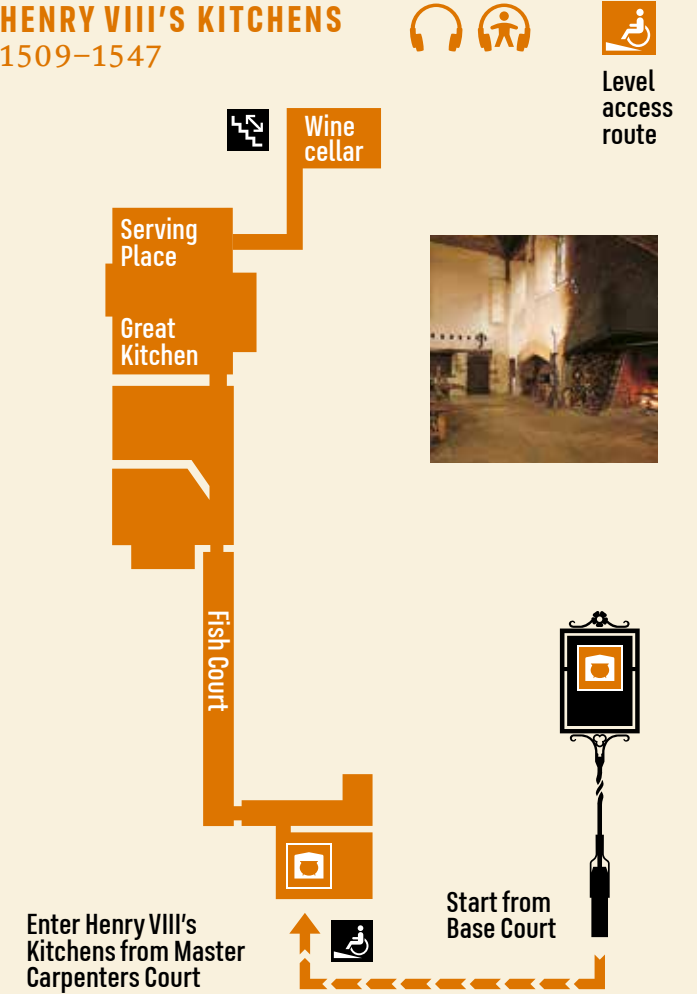

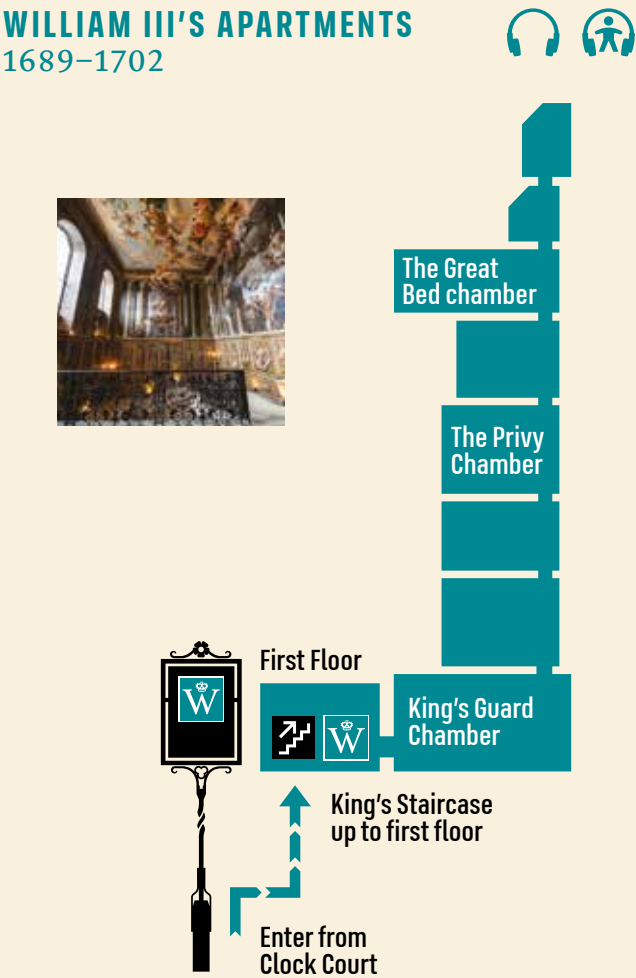

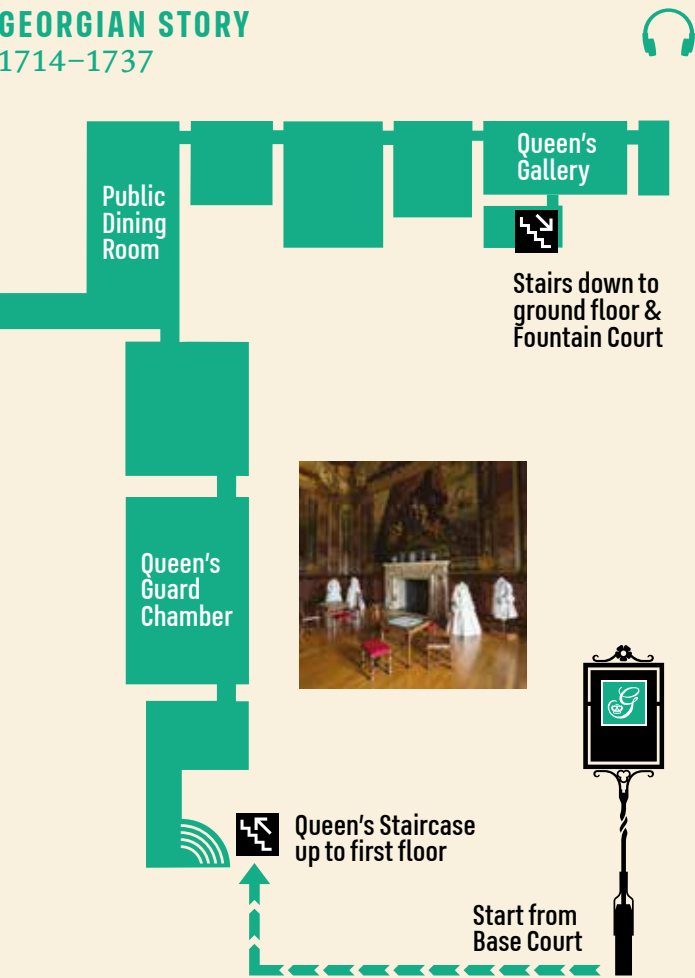

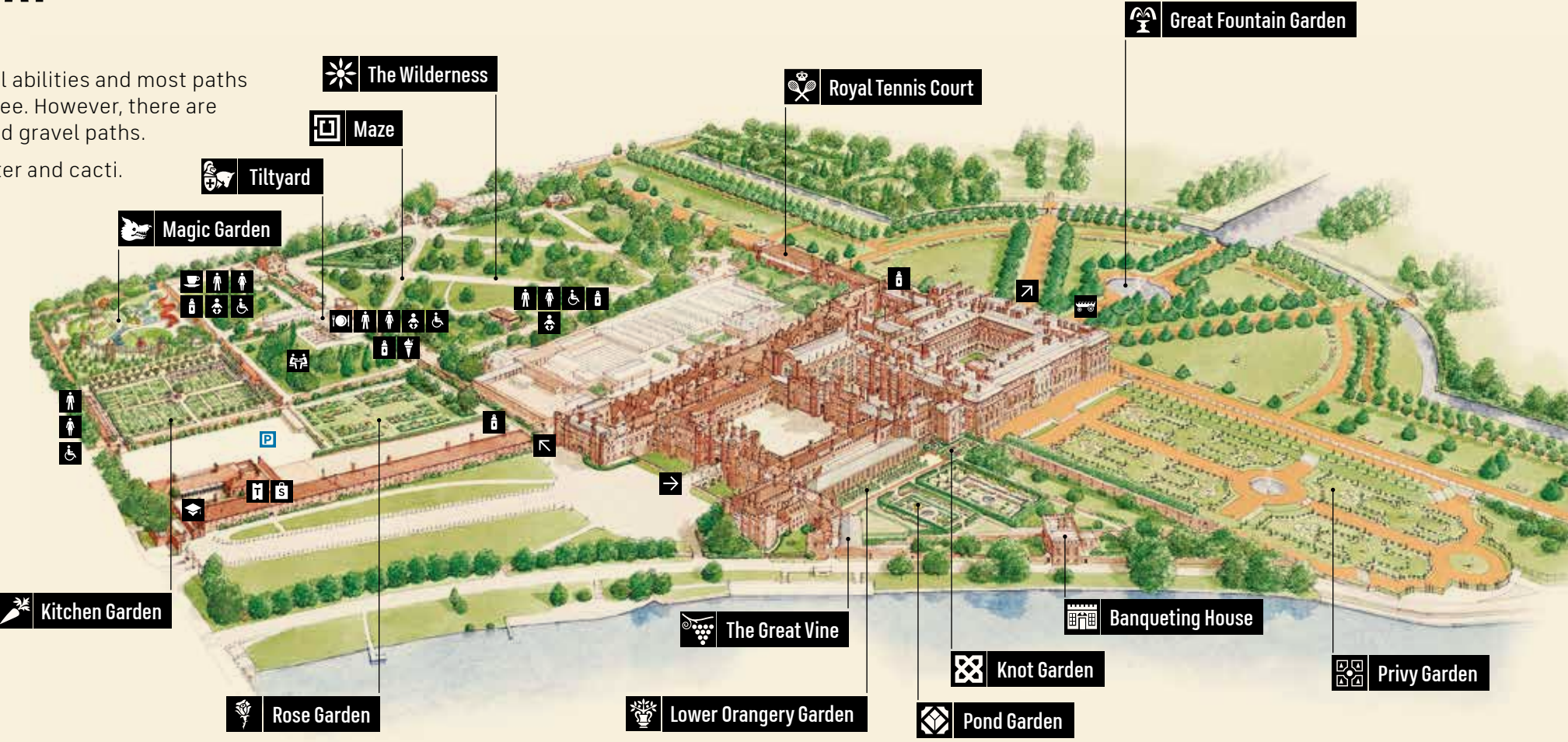
# GARDENS MAP

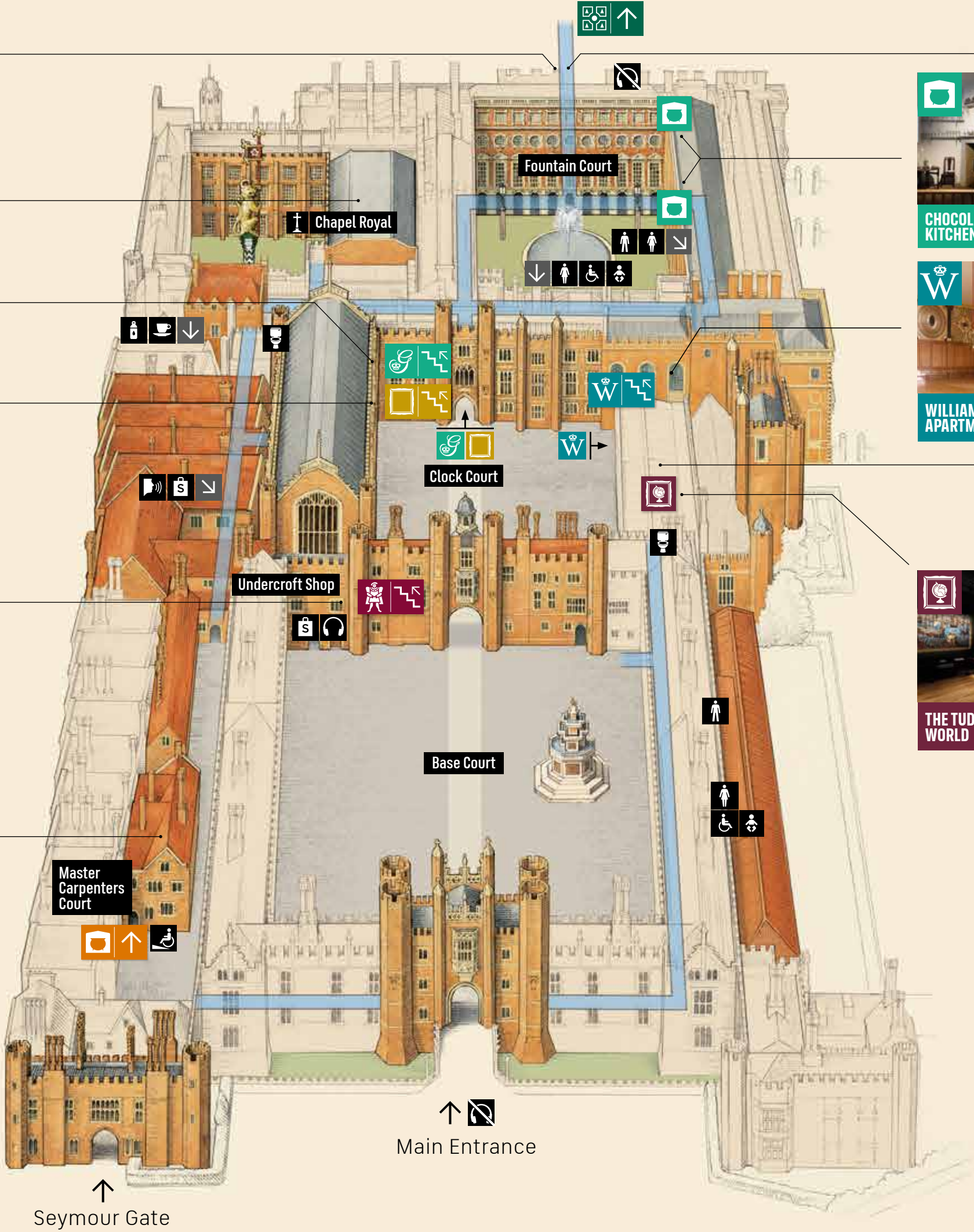

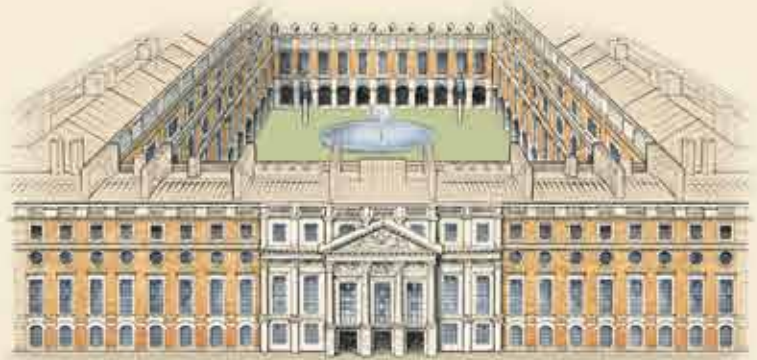
